

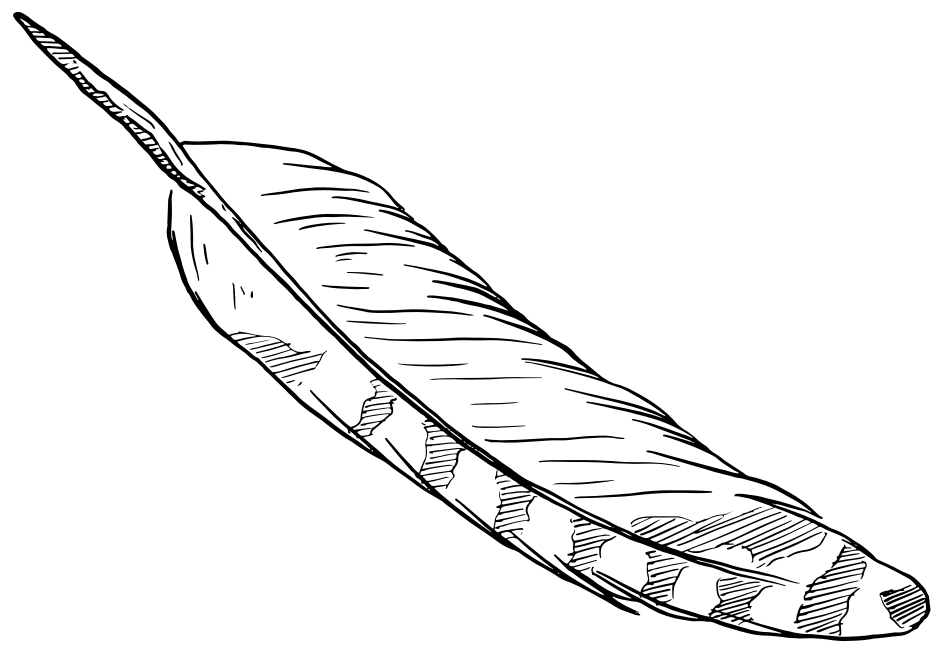

My name is Mandi Rushton, I am excited to be at EE Oliver this year to promote positive mental health!

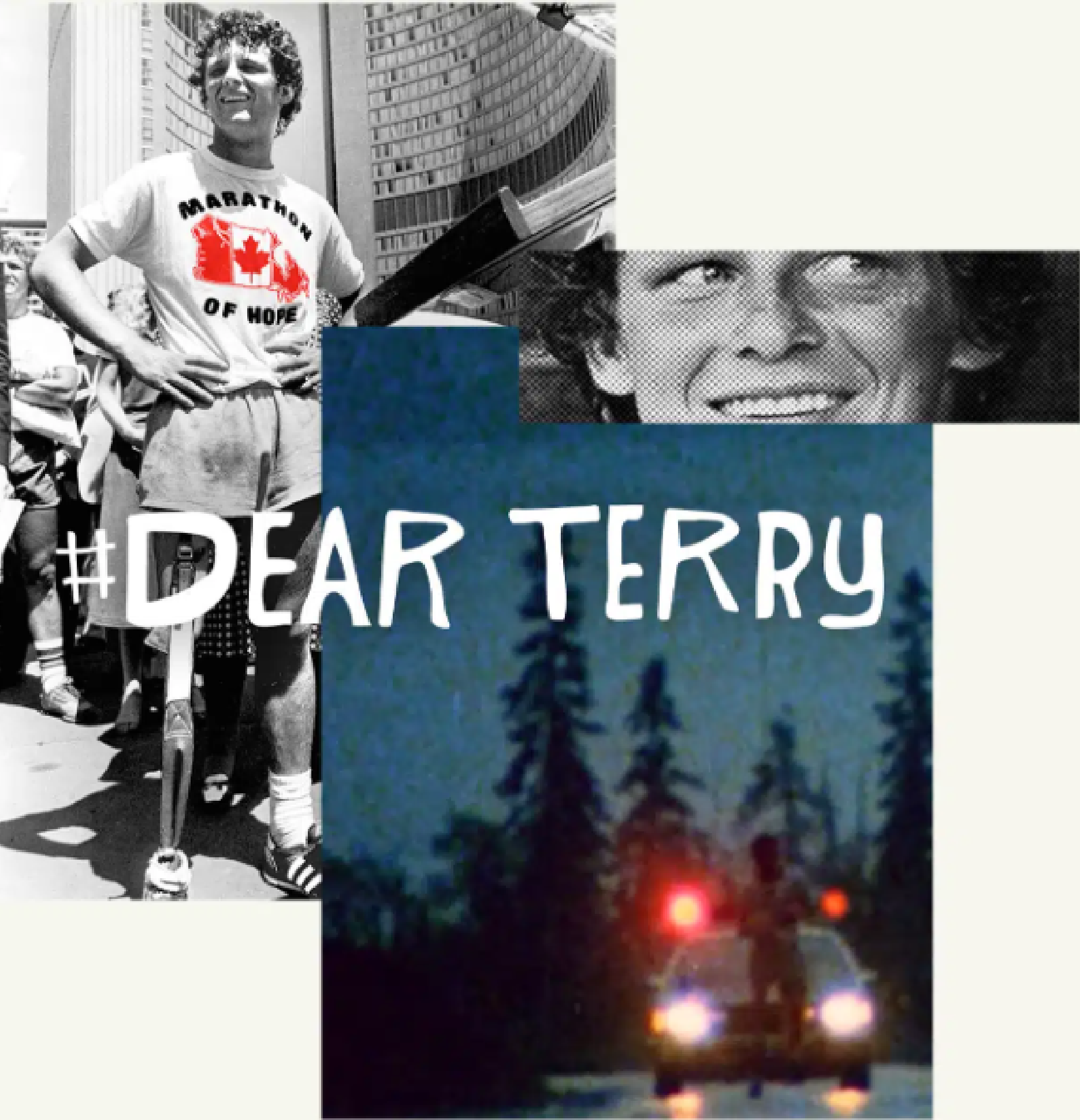
All About me

NATIONAL DAY FOR TRUTH AND RECONCILIATION

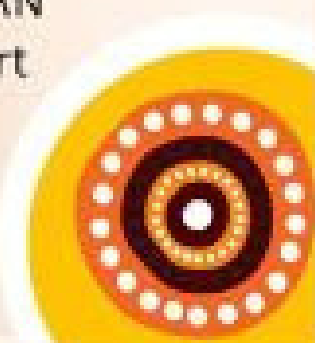
September 30

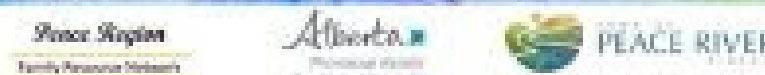
