Percentage of Students, Parents and Staff who agree the PRSD ...

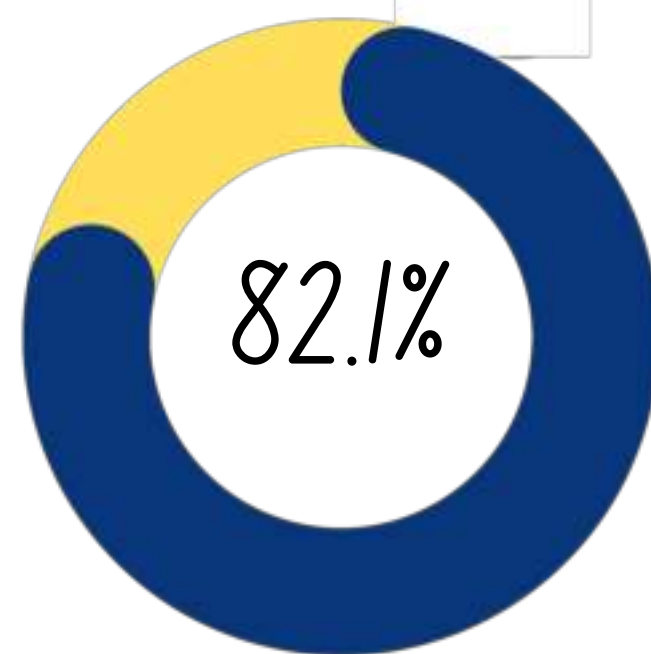

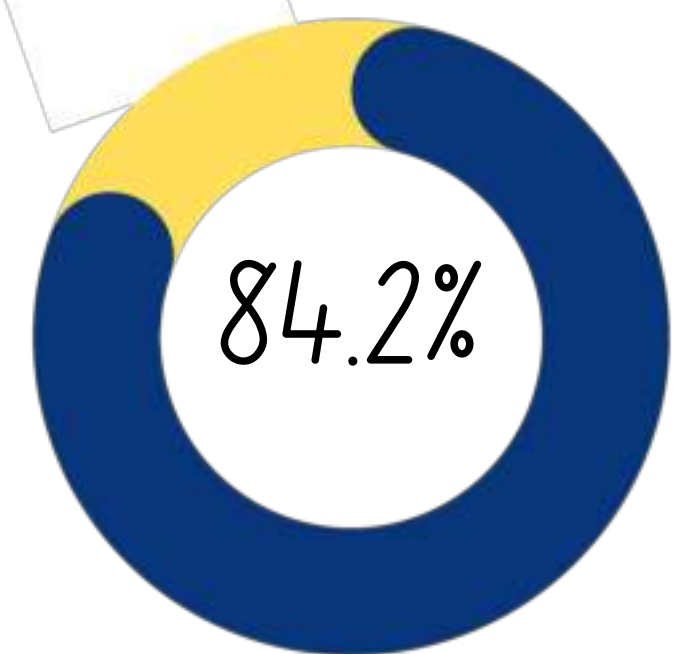

If you have questions about the survey completion, please reach out to your school's principal for clarification. They will be very willing to assist you.

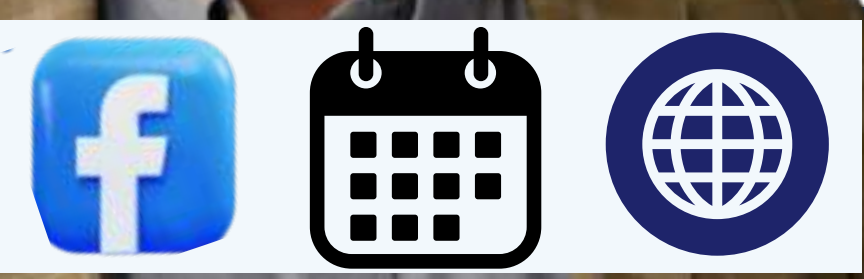
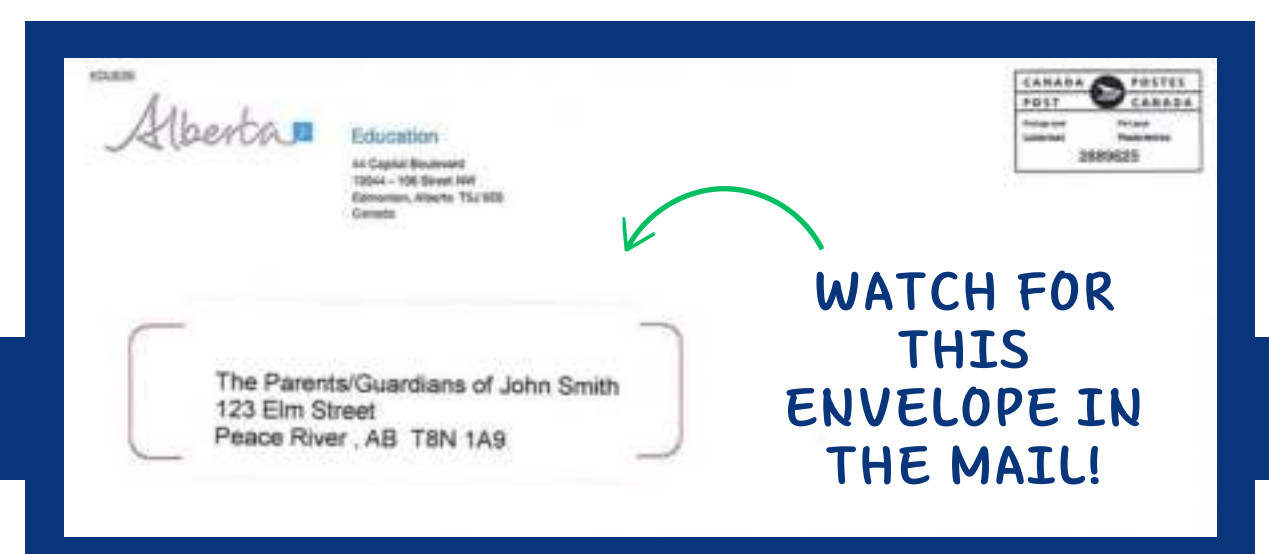
Student success is incredibly important to us. As you may know, our funding is based on student enrollment. The higher the enrollment, the more supports we can offer to better serve our students to be more successful.

In Canada, 57% of children 6 to 11 years of age have had a cavity, while tooth decay accounts for one third of all day surgeries performed in hospitals for kids between the ages of 1 and 5. 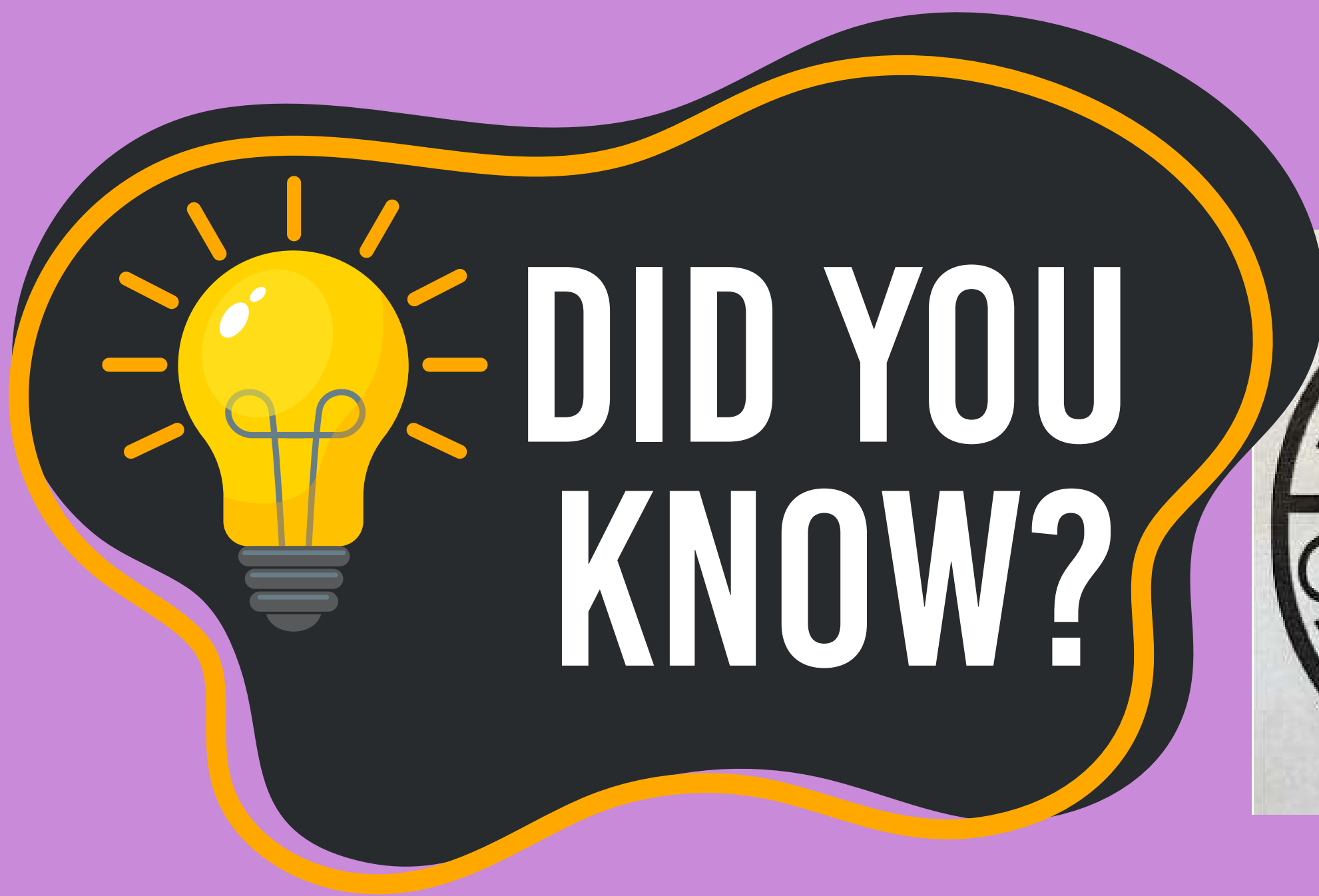

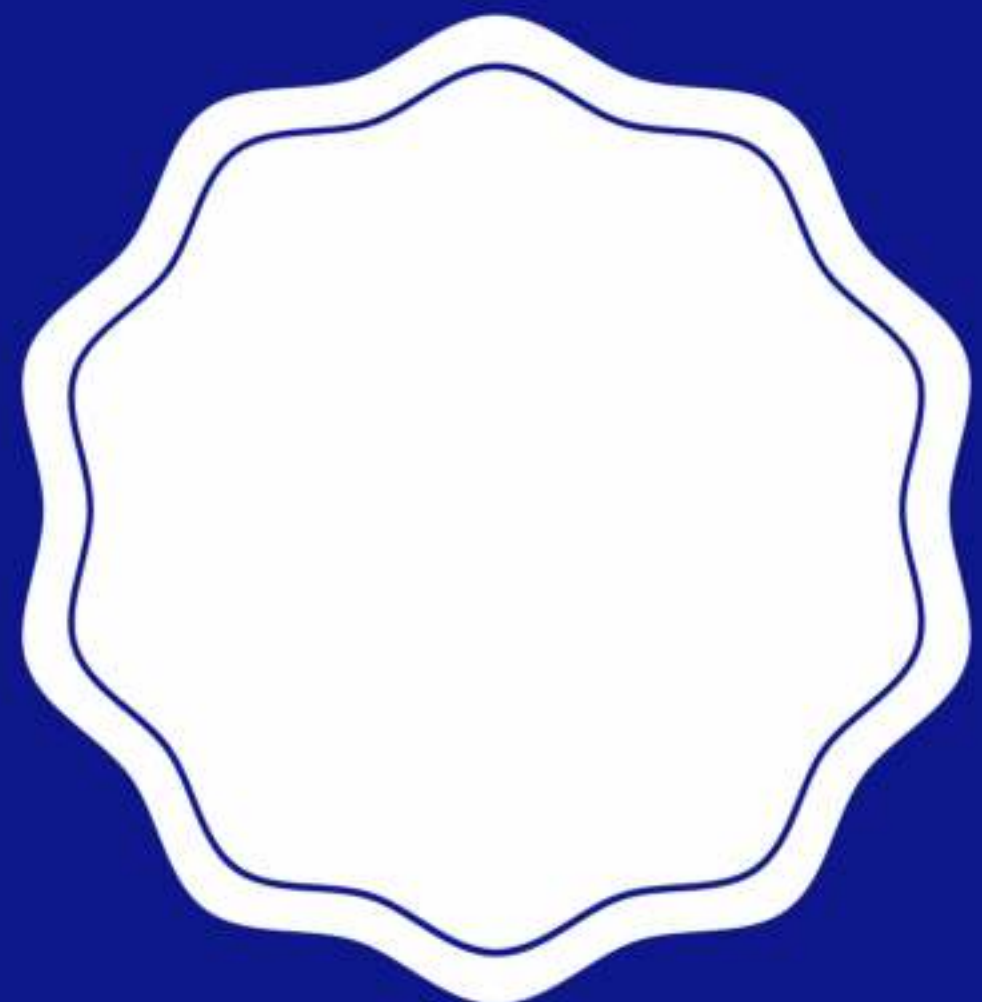
